2026 WOODCLIFF LAKE FIRE DEPARTMENT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Woodcliff Lake Volunteer Fire Department Scholarship Program was designed to assist our community's students in furthering their education and achieving their goals.

Listed below are the rules and guidelines for this award.

1. Only graduating high school students residing in the Borough of Woodcliff Lake or members of the Woodcliff Lake Fire Department are eligible for an award.
2. Only students who submit a completed application, including a transcript, by April 1, 2026, will be considered for the awards.
3. Applicants may be interviewed at the Woodcliff Lake Fire Department on a date agreeable to both the Scholarship Committee and the applicant.
4. Scholarships will be awarded in June at Woodcliff Lake Fire Department Headquarters or the local high school senior awards night.
5. **All submitted applications must include a copy of the applicant's school transcript documenting the grade average for all four years.**
6. Completed applications must be returned to Woodcliff Lake Borough Hall by 4:00 PM Tuesday, April 1, 2026. Please submit all applications in a sealed envelope to the "Woodcliff Lake Fire Department Scholarship Committee."
7. All information submitted to the Scholarship Committee will be held in complete confidence.
8. Applications are rated not only on grades but also on character, ambition, goals, financial need, and community service.
