3. Applicants may be interviewed at the Woodcliff Lake Fire Department on an agreeable date for both the Scholarship Committee and applicant.
4. Scholarships will be awarded at the June Town Council Public Meeting at the Borough Hall.
5. **All submitted applications must include a copy of the applicant's school transcript documenting grade average for all four years.**
6. Completed applications are to be returned to the Woodcliff Lake Borough Hall by no later than 4:00 PM Wednesday, May 6, 2020 Please submit all applications in a sealed envelope addressed as follows; "Woodcliff Lake Fire Department Scholarship Committee".
7. All information submitted to the Scholarship Committee will be held in complete confidence.
8. Applications are rated not only on grades but character, ambition, goals, financial need and community service.
